Where were we?

In our previous newsletter of August 2024 you read what we did in the second quarter of this year. For example, on May 11, we organized a plant market in Stiphout for the second time. We sold about 100 plant species and various homemade products through upcycling. This activity will definitely be repeated in May 2025!

On June 10, it was time for the second duo bike trip. With a group of 10 guests and 10 volunteer cyclists, we cycled a beautiful route again. Unfortunately, we are unable to do duo biking again this year, but given everyone's enthusiasm, it will certainly be continued!

In between, we also provided a church service in our own unique way. Based on the theme *inside out*, we tried to connect people from inside and outside the church through a varied program.

In addition, we introduced our 2 Kenyan participants in the previous newsletter. They will be joining us on a work trip to Kenya next July and are already doing great research for our 2025-2028 project, in which we want to plant mangrove forests and introduce ways to upcycle plastic waste and cook on solar energy.
